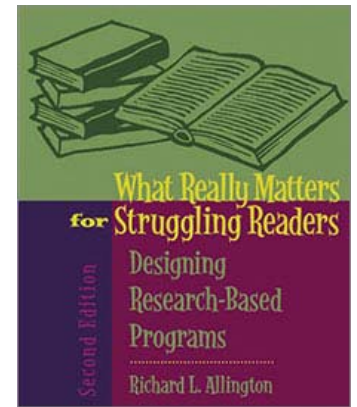


INTERVENTION FOR STRUGGLING READERS: WHAT REALLY MATTERS
